### Notice to Exhibitors

The Trial Secretary is not responsible for emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 24 hours, please call the Trial Secretary by telephone.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, covid, or any other causes beyond the control of Jefferson County Kennel Club.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules.

Junior Handlers must complete the back of the entry form.

**Please include only AKC titles on your entries.**

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Post Dated and Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience/Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per class for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a veterinarian of such a claim not later than 30 minutes before the start of judging of the first class in the trial.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must always be on lead or crated except when in the ring. All 'warm ups" MUST be done ON LEAD. The lead is attached to the dog's collar and the handler is holding the lead.

**Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at the show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.**

**Covid Precautions:** We reserve the right to require exhibitors to wear a mask. This will be based on covid statistics in the area on the date of the trial.

Missouri state law requires all dogs participating in dog shows be free of clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease and must be vaccinated for rabies; dogs traveling from outside of the state are also required to have a certificate of veterinary inspection.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Jefferson County Kennel Club. has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date other than change from A to B with written request and move ups.

No refunds for duplicate entries.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Jefferson County Kennel Club, its Board, Members, and Purina Event Center and it's employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

Prizes will not be mailed.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Trials.

- NO XPENS will be ALLOWED - Dogs may not be left overnight

- Bring your own chairs and water for your dog.
- Bitches in Season are not allowed on the show grounds.
- All dogs are to be kept on leash in compliance with the AKC rules.

### AKC Event & Recording Fees

A Recording Fee of \$0.50 cents and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for the first entry of each dog and a \$3.00 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC Licensed or Member Club Events. (Chapter 11, Section 2 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows). A Recording Fee of \$3.50 shall be required for the first entry of each dog and a Recording Fee of \$3.00 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog. (Chapter 1, Section 5 of Rally Regulations). Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. Dogs entered in both Obedience and Rally at the same trial (AM or PM) are required to pay two (2) "First Entry" fees. Dogs entered in both Obedience, or both Rally trials on Friday and Saturday are required to pay (2) "First Entry" fees."

Entries must be signed and include the full-page AGREEMENT on the back of (or attached to) the entry form. Incomplete entries are not valid and WILL BE RETURNED.

**RV RESERVATIONS**

**Purina Farms Overnight Camping Reservation Request Form**

Thank you for requesting an overnight camping space in one of the Purina Farms designated RV lots. Reservations are taken on a first-come; first-served basis and are assigned based on length of equipment (rig) and space availability. If confirmed, you will receive an emailed confirmation and a payment link so you can pay at your convenience. Our RV Engagement Specialist will respond back to your reservation request within 5- 7 business days to let you know whether your reservation is confirmed. Full payment must be received before the space can be finalized. Purina Farms offers 2 different RV lots on property. The Full-Service Purina Event Center RV lot offers 30 and 50 amp electric, water and sewer. The Electric Only Main Show Field RV lot offers 30 and 50 amp electric. The nightly charge is \$50/night (Row A), \$45/night (Row B) and \$40/night (Rows C & D) in the Full-Service Purina Event Center Lot\* and \$25 in the Electric Only Main Show Field RV Lot. Full payment by credit card must be received before the space can be confirmed and finalized. There is no guarantee of site assignment. Any RVs bigger than 50’ must reserve a spot in the full-service Purina Event Center lot. Max size of RV on property is 55’. Tow vehicles are not factored into the length of the spaces as they must be unhooked. Spaces are refundable if canceled more than 3 days out from the arrival date listed on the reservation confirmation. Otherwise, no refunds will be given. Spaces are non-transferable. Please note that RV reservations are only accepted for those entered (or those who have dogs/cats entered) in an event that has contracted space, which includes the overnight camping lots. The Purina Farms RV lots are only open to vehicles specifically designed with overnight sleeping accommodations including motorhomes, fifth wheels and travel trailers. 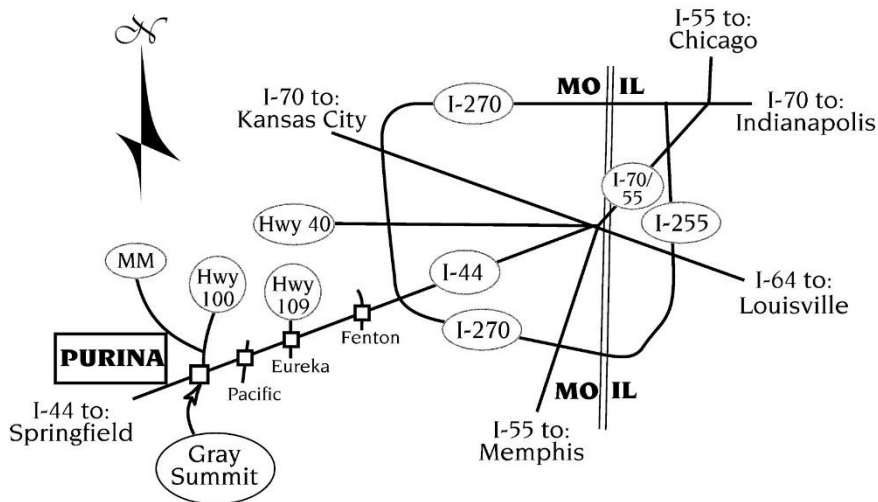
**Hotels**

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 inches, over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired); Collies (rough, smooth); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed". Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
